KINDERGARTEN

√ Qty. Item

ALL CHILDREN NEED:

- 1 plastic folders with pockets
- 4 boxes (24) crayola crayons
- 4 #2 Laddie pencils w/erasers (fat pencils)
- 4 expo dry erase markers
- 2 packs of 4 Elmer's glue sticks (8 glue sticks total)
- 4 bottles of 4 oz. Elmer's white school glue
- 1 Jumbo coloring book for inside recess
- 2 box Clorox wipes-**GIRLS**
- 4 box baby wipes-**BOYS**
- 1 box Ziploc bags, Gallon size (24 ct.)
- 1 box Ziploc bags, Quart size (24 ct.)

ALL CHILDREN NEED:

- 4 12 packs of yellow No. 2 pencils (American made only)
- 2 block eraser

- 1 scissors (metal blade with plastic handle)
- 10 glue sticks (white only and Not Liquid)
- 1 2-pocket folder (any color - no prongs)
- 4 large boxes of tissues (200 count)
- 1 ream of printer paper 8.5 x 11 20lb.
- 1 small school supply box (approx. 5"x8"x2")
- 1 book bag or backpack (bring daily)
- 1 paint shirt or art smock for art class (old shirt that fits easily over clothing)
- 1 coloring book (for indoor recess)
- 1 box of baby wipes

GIRLS ONLY ALSO BRING:

- 1 roll of paper towels
- 1 container Lysol or Clorox sanitizing wipes

BOYS ONLY ALSO BRING:

- 1 box of gallon size zip lock style bags
- 1 hand sanitizer, 12 fl.oz.
