



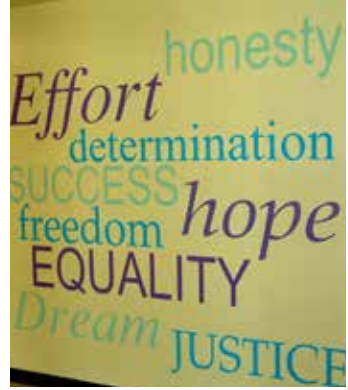

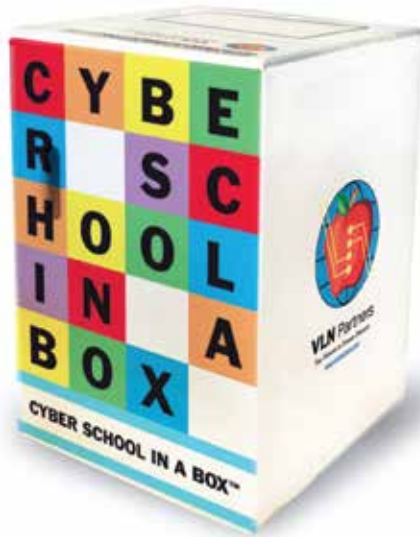
TECHNICAL SUPPORT
